Karl Shiflett and his band members look as if they just stepped off the stage at the Grand Ole Opry with Roy Acuff and The Smokey Mountain Boys. They aren't merely imitating that sound and look, it's who they *are*. This band carries on the tradition of country music by writing new material in the traditional vein. Shiflett draws his inspiration for their live act from the early recordings of WSM's legendary radio show, The Grand Ole Opry. The band's vintage sound recalls that pivotal point in musical history just before country music began separate into genres such as "bluegrass", "country" and "western swing". The current line-up of The Karl Shiflett & Big Country Show includes: Karl Shiflett- lead vocals and rhythm guitar, Kris Shiflett- harmony vocals and acoustic upright bass, Jake Jenkins- harmony vocals and 5-string banjo, Randy Lindley- harmony vocals and mandolin, Chuck Westerman- harmony vocals and fiddle, and finally Andy Ruff- harmony vocals and dobro. The International Bluegrass Music Association recently selected The Karl Shiflett & Big Country Show as Emerging Artist of the Year.

Back At The Ranch is the latest hot new trio to the Western and Cowboy Swing genre. An amazing trio sure to demand your attention, BATR delivers a swinging blend of music with Clover Carroll on guitar and resophonic guitar, Rachel Carroll on upright bass and Matthew Menke playing fiddle. The effortless ease with which the trio performs their classic selections will, as Red Steagall says, "...knock your hat in the creek!" Their upbeat stage presence and hilarious antics blend seamlessly together with pure harmonies and professional musicianship for a top-notch performance.

All three members of the band are from small towns in Texas and bear the influences of the tradition of music the state is steeped in. Rachel's stunning lead vocals are the magnet that draws the group together. Clover's unique fingerstyle guitar playing is the culmination of the influences of Merle Travis, Eldon Shamblin and Chet Atkins. Matthew Menke, hailed "Ace Fiddle Player" by the Austin Chronicle, plays in a style flavored by Johnny Gimble, Tiny Moore and Kenny Baker.
